

Notice of Restoration Grant Application
January 25, 2017

The Center for Sierra Nevada Conservation (CSNC) is developing an application for Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) Cooperative Funds for the upcoming 2016/2017 grant cycle. We are developing a preliminary application to the Off Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division for a restoration grant for restoring “pioneered” routes; restoration and protection of Lava Caps and associated sensitive plant species and monitoring restored areas. Currently, CSNC does restoration throughout the Eldorado National Forest. We invite the public to suggest specific areas that may be in need of restoration. We also welcome other ideas regarding this project in advance of submitting our application.
