As a member of the public and someone who recreates in the Eldorado National Forest high country, I object to the Draft Decision and FONSI which puts the desires of a handful of off road recreationists over the beneficial uses of water and the protection of Threatened and Endangered Species. Meadows, always a scarce and valuable natural resource, are even more important now, as we face climate change and drought. Mountain Yellow-Legged frogs and Yosemite Toads are facing extinction, yet this decision knowingly and willfully puts their survival on the Eldorado at risk. These roads should be permanently closed to motor vehicles, and the damage to the meadows and other sensitive riparian resources repaired.
