

Notice of Restoration Grant Application – March 5, 2016

The Center for Sierra Nevada Conservation (CSNC) has developed a preliminary application for California State Parks Off Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division Restoration Grant for the 2015/2016 grant cycle. The grant will support CSNC's work identifying and restoring user-created vehicle routes; restoration and protection of Lava Caps and associated sensitive plant species and monitoring restored areas. We are seeking the public's comments on the preliminary application.

The 30-day public review and comment period for the 2015/2016 Grants and Cooperative Agreement Program begins March 8, 2016, and ends April 4, 2016.
